

Building on Bones:

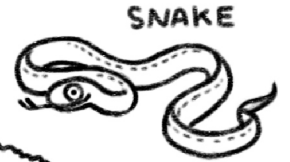
After paleontologists find fossils, they try to figure out what those animals looked like when they were alive.
